

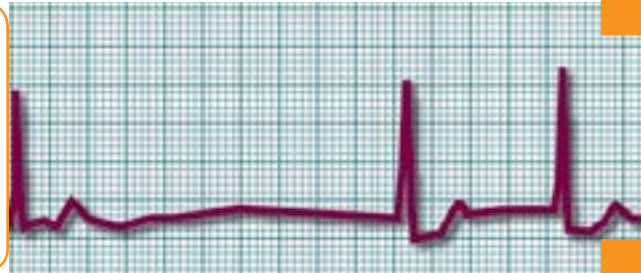
## 2016 Atrial Fibrillation Study Days
